**ORDER**

HAVING CONSIDERED Plaintiff's Motion (doc. 3) for a Temporary Restraining Order;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, this 10th day of June, 2011, at 5:40 p.m., that the Defendant, the City of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, is hereby enjoined from enforcing its two (2) unrelated persons residing in an A-I zone rule as stated the Defendant's Unified Development Code in particular Title 7, Chapter 8, Section 8.20 against Oxford. In addition, the Defendant is enjoined from enforcing the provisions of the "Special Home" ordinance as it pertains to the granting of reasonable accommodation to only those housing providers for the disabled that are licensed by the Louisiana and provide 24-hour staffing until a hearing is held on this matter. This order shall apply only to enforcement actions by the City of Baton Rouge as it applies to 4224 Drusilla Lane and 1858 Shawn Drive.
